## REPORT CARD DAY



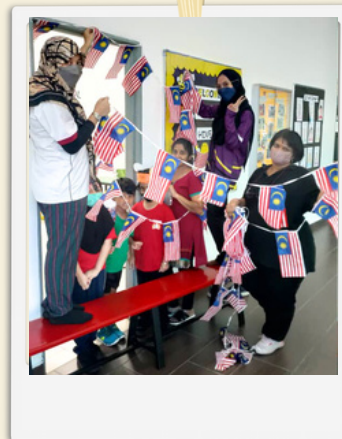

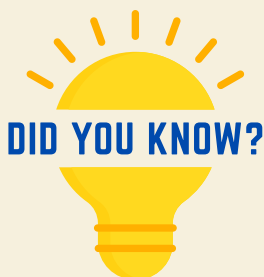
