The Academic Team is happy to announce that the Term 1 exams were concluded successfully for Level 1 & Level 2 students.

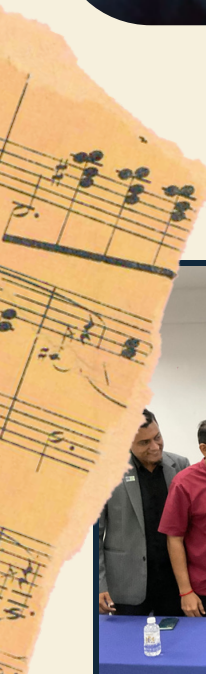
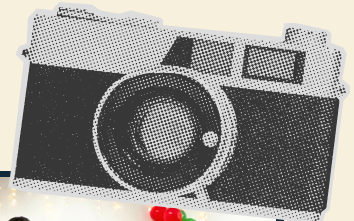
