Let me take you on the journey so far.

Our journey started well with the finalising of the **New Cafeteria Operator** who will start serving meals in the new academic year. Big Bites Canteen as what the canteen will be called now, will offer fusion cuisine that is healthy, nutritious and delicious that will most certainly suit the taste buds of every Zenithian. We have ensured there is a meal plan option for Preschool, Year 1 and Year 2 students, which will give parents the convenience as well as hassle free schooling days for their precious little children. You will find the exciting menu items with pricing as an appendix to this newsletter.

Part of the overall plan is to ensure that we stay true to our campus name, “White House Campus”, so every wall inside the campus building - the classrooms, the corridors, the staircases has been given a **Shining and Glowing White Finish**. Outside walls of the campus will get a bright white and gold finish making our beloved campus look majestic and attractive - a beacon of education in Seremban, a second home to our students. One of the other major works being done currently is **Renovating The Roof** to ensure the problems of leakages and water dripping when it rains is gone forever. The exceptional weather has not helped the roll out of the external work but we will get it done and all Zenithians will be proud.

Other internal work that has been done is to **Refurbish All The Lockers** and placing them in a common area which will reduce the chance of any accident happening but greatly improving the safety, the usability and rest assured aesthetically pleasing. The next phase will be an exciting development for all the Zenithian sports enthusiast - once the roof work has been completed, we will be installing a competition level basketball court there - with sports court floor surfacing but with fencing and all other necessary safety measures being put in place.

Now to what will make Zenith International School the best place for quality education in Negeri Sembilan - we have finalised and rolled out the Zenith International School **Teaching & Learning Policy** which has as its foundation 10 guiding principles. This policy is linked to the 6 Core Teacher's Performance Standards that will be upheld by our Queens and Kings (our beloved teachers) to ensure the delivery of the best education is given to our students. This was introduced and discussed during the successful completion of the 2023/2024 Academic Year Teacher's Induction week. We are also thankful to our education partners. **Cambridge University Press** for holding a face-to-face training for the teachers to further upskill our teachers allowing them to deliver what they have learnt to our students.

To ensure that all students enrolled at Zenith International School focus on their education and doing right things as well as doing things right, the **Student Handbook** has been revamped with a whole new disciplinary system in place. Employees of Zenith International School have also been given a new handbook which sets out all the employment policies which new and existing employees are to follow in their daily duties. Rollout will be in phases but will give all stakeholders a detailed view of the weekly and yearly planning covering the lesson topics, the learning objectives, the learning activity, materials used, homework and any assessment done in each and every class/subject. July 21st 2023 marked the day we had our very first **Zenith International School Townhall**. A very Big Thank you to all the parents who made the time to attend this event. Parents were excited to hear about the 10th Anniversary Rebate Scheme and were briefed on the new Academic Policies, new CCA & ECA activities as well as game changing subject/syllabus changes that will be implemented in the near future.

The first days of the 2023/2024 Academic Year are fast approaching and to keep parents informed, the new format Academic Calendar has been designed with its term and weekly format, This will allow all to view the impactful activities planned for all the students, for all the teachers by the teachers, by the School. 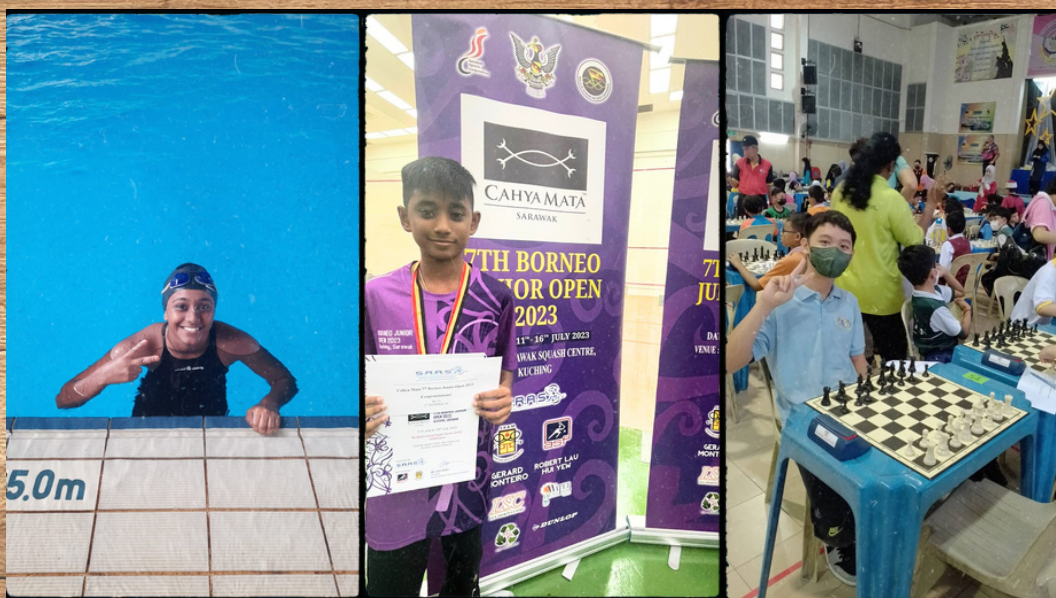

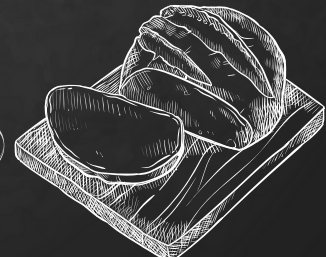

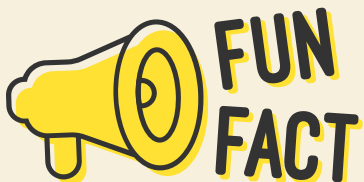
