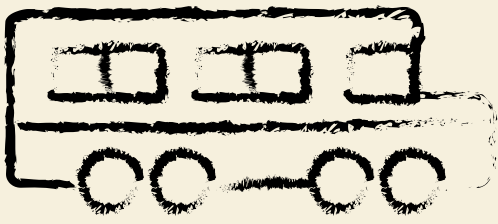

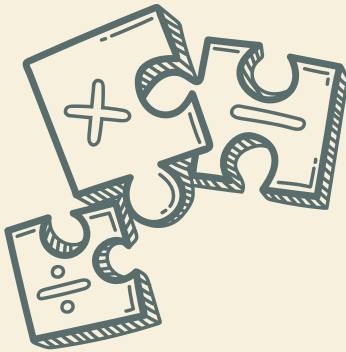


When the moon is directly overhead, you will weigh slightly less
