Magnetic Wonders at Zenith Preschool!

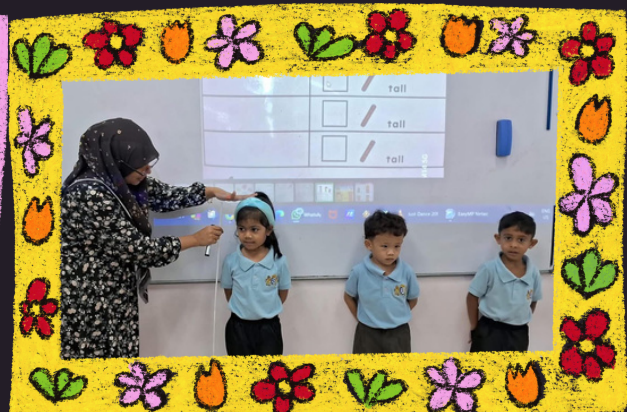
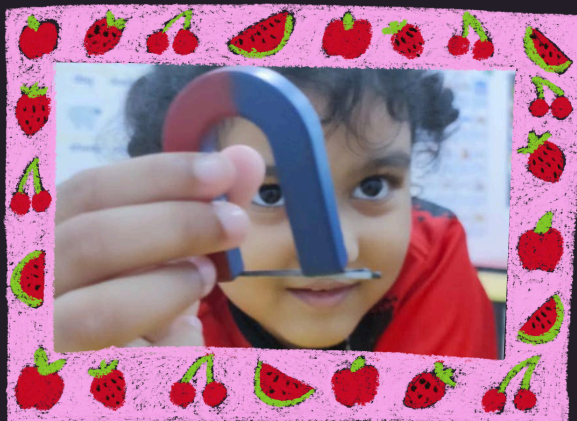

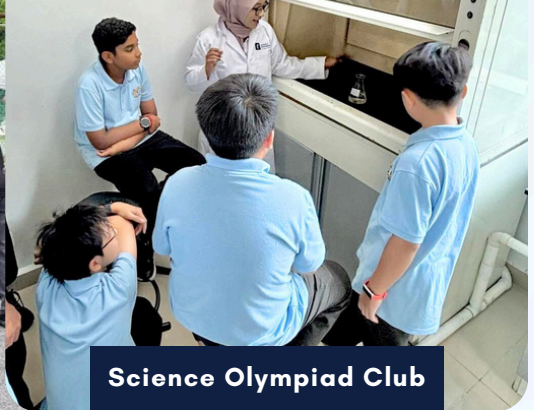
