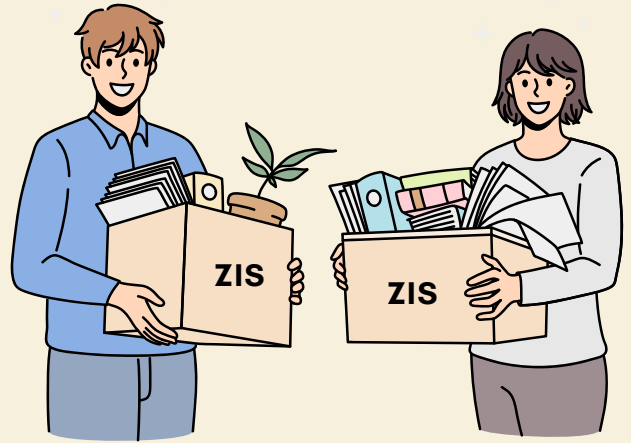
## WELCOMING NEW ZENITHIANS!
